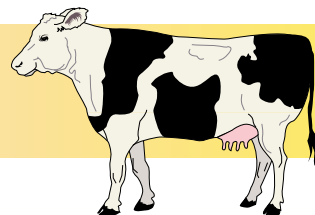

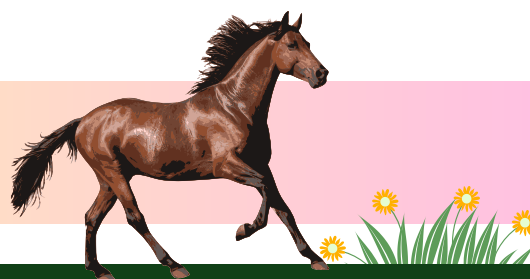

Parenting Tips

**“Animals are friends, gentle and kind,
Teach your child to love them, with care in mind.”**

Children are naturally curious and often excited when they see animals. As parents, it is our duty to guide them on how to handle animals with love, patience, and respect, while also keeping themselves safe. Here are some Animal Parenting Tips you can share with your little ones.

Gentle & Comfort Teaching children how to handle animalsing Routine

1. Tell your child never to pull an animal's tail, ears, or fur. Such actions hurt animals and may make them angry.
2. Teach them to move slowly and calmly near animals, without shouting, teasing, or chasing them.
- * After meeting or touching animals
3. Remind children to wash their hands properly with soap and water.
4. Ask them to change or dust their clothes if they have played closely with pets, to maintain hygiene.

Cleanliness & Hygiene Tips

1. Keep nails trimmed so dirt from playing with pets doesn't stay trapped.
2. Remind them not to touch their face, mouth, or food before washing hands after being around animals.
3. What parents should teach about animals
4. Animals also have feelings, they get hungry, thirsty, tired, or scared just like us.
5. Children should learn that feeding fresh, clean food is kindness, while spoiled food can make animals sick.

How children can protect themselves

1. If they see a stray dog barking, tell them not to run or throw stones, but to stay calm and walk away slowly
2. Teach them to always keep a safe distance from unknown animals and never touch without an adult nearby.
3. What children should learn about food for animals
4. Always give animals fresh and clean food. Just like us, they deserve meals that are safe and healthy.
5. Never give spoiled or stale food, it can upset their stomach and make them very sick.

What to feed pets & stray animals

1. Pet dogs can eat dog food, boiled rice, eggs, veggies, or chicken prepared simply (without too much oil or spice).
2. Stray dogs can be given chapati, rice, biscuits, or simple food but never chocolate, chips, or fried snacks, as these harm them.



How can parents indulge their children in animal care?

1. Involve them in small routines, let children pour water into the pet's bowl, help serve food, or brush the pet gently. Small tasks make them feel responsible and connected.
2. Teach through example ~ Children copy what parents do. If parents show kindness by feeding strays calmly, respecting zoo rules, or cleaning up after pets, kids will naturally follow.

Rules alone can feel a little heavy for children, but when wrapped in rhyme, they become easy to remember and fun to follow. To help your little ones learn kindness towards animals, here's a sweet poem you can teach them:

Be Kind to Animals :

Love the animals, gentle and sweet,
Give them fresh water, clean food to eat.
Don't pull their tails, don't make them cry,
Walk away calmly if strays pass by.
At the zoo, follow rules, don't shout or tease,
Respect their space, let them live in peace.
Wash your hands after play each day, Kindness
to animals is the safest way.
