

# Parenting Tips Turn Puddles Into Possibilities

# **Greetings Dear Parents**

The monsoon is here, bringing cool breezes, cozy evenings, and of course, muddy shoes and sneaky sniffles! While children love the magic of rainy days, they also need a little extra care to stay healthy and happy. Here are some thoughtful Monsoon Parenting Tips to help you turn rainy-day worries into wonderful memories.

# Label your belongings

- Label the belongings to help your child identify their belongings.
- Keep an extra pair of socks and a dress.
- Use waterproof covers inside bags to keep books and notebooks dry.

# Protection from Mosquitoes

- Use child-safe mosquito repellent patches, roll-ons or creams.
- Avoid outdoor play near puddles, plants, or stagnant water .

# **Light & Safe Food**

- Serve light, fresh home food like khichdi, dal-rice, or soft chapatis with vegetables .
- Avoid junk food, especially street food, fruit chaat, and outside juices, as they may be made with dirty ice or unclean water which can lead to stomach infections.
- Include turmeric milk, seasonal vegetables and fruits in daily meals to boost immunity.

## **Fun Indoor Activities**

• Keep children happily engaged with by making paper boats and going for a nature walk .(Limit screen time as much as possible.)

#### **Light Morning Movement**

• A few minutes of gentle stretching in the morning helps improve blood flow and makes your child feel active and fresh before school.

#### **Proper Rest is Essential**

• Children should sleep for at least 9 to 10 hours every night.

#### Gentle & Comforting Routine

- Spice up the cozy evenings with storytelling over hot & healthy snacks.
- "Memories last a lifetime". End with a sweet 'happy memory time' reminding them of something good from the day to build positive thoughts.
- In the rainy season, children need extra help to stay fresh, clean, and healthy. A few small daily habits can prevent common monsoon-related issues and keep them cheerful and comfortable.

#### **Everyday Hygiene**

- Good hygiene keeps infections away, especially during the rainy season.
- Teach your child to wash hands properly after using the washroom, before eating, and after outdoor play.
- Keep nails trimmed and clean to avoid dirt and germs.
- Encourage the use of a clean handkerchief while sneezing or coughing.
- After sweating (especially after play), gently wipe underarms with a soft damp towel to prevent rashes.
- Clean ears regularly using cotton ear buds (with adult help) to prevent wax buildup.



## **Body Care Routine**

- Taking care of the body, skin, and hair is very important in the monsoon.
- Give your child a warm shower before bedtime to keep them relaxed and fresh.
- Use a gentle baby shower gel and follow it with baby oil or lotionto lock in moisture.
- Use a mild clarifying shampoo twice a week to keep the scalp clean and avoid lice or dirt buildup.
- A light moisturiser and a soft lip balm or chapstick help keep skin and lips soft and healthy.
- Most importantly, help your child feel fresh and smell good this boosts their comfort and confidence in the humid weather.

With these simple steps and a little extra care, we can keep our little ones happy, healthy, and smiling all through the monsoon.
